At the historic **Higginson House**, **87** Mount Vernon Street, Boston MA.

Designed by Charles Bulfinch in 1804 and built by 1806, the Higginson House contains carving by Simeon Skillin and is maintained in a surprisingly intact condition as the headquarters of the Colonial Society in Massachusetts. Located on Beacon Hill, it is easily accessible from Park Street Station on the Red or Green Lines or Charles Street Station on the Red Line.
