

Executive Director Triangle Global Health Consortium 11 March 2013

The Triangle Global Health Consortium (TGHC) (www.triangleglobalhealth.org), a non-profit organization based in Research Triangle Park, NC and dedicated to improving global health, seeks a full-time, experienced and innovative manager to serve as Executive Director. The ideal candidate will have strong leadership and executive management skills; a background in international/global health with strong strategic decision-making and fiscal management experience; proven funding development capability; and a passion for improving the health of the world's communities. S/he will bring vision, creativity, and strong communication skills. Reporting to the Board of Directors, the TGHC Executive Director is responsible for leading a public-private consortium dedicated to promoting collaborative research, integrating scientific programs across institutions, inspiring and mentoring future researchers and teachers, and establishing and maintaining signature member series. S/he will work in close collaboration with the Executive Committee and serve as the driving force in the development and execution of the Consortium's business strategy to elevate the organization's public profile and achieve long and short term revenue goals and objectives.

Founded in 2009 as a partnership of Duke University, North Carolina State University, The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, Family Health International (FHI), IntraHealth International, RTI International (RTI), and the North Carolina Biotechnology Center, the TGHC has grown to more than 20 organizational members, including five academic institutions, several non-governmental organizations, and a growing number of multinational corporate members.

Qualifications:

Graduate or professional degree (e.g., PhD, Masters in Public Health, or Masters with related experience); demonstrated understanding of global public health, including global, national and local policy issues; ability to manage and grow an active member portfolio; capacity to work effectively within the university, non-governmental, commercial, and/or government environments; one-to-one and large groups presentation skills; experience in advocacy, constituency building, and fund-raising; and demonstrated ability to effectively connect with individuals at all professional levels. Flexible schedule and salary is commensurate with experience.

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Responsibilities:

- Provide executive leadership for growing the consortium to ensure long term financial sustainability through the development of membership and fundraising strategies across multiple stakeholder groups.
- Lead the continual development of the TGHC business strategy, including creative direction, support and evolution of the strategy to market the consortium's global health-related capabilities to government agencies and representatives, non- government organizations and foundations that fund relevant programs.
- Identify public and private funding opportunities and establish cross-organizational teams for successful proposal development.
- Work with the TGHC Board and participating organizations to support cohesive branding, communications and messaging for the Consortium.
- Organize and promote regional and international workshops, seminars, and conferences that showcase TGHC programs and expertise.
- Represent the TGHC locally and nationally to build and strengthen external relationships, identify and cultivate additional organizational and individual members, potential donors and friends of the TGHC.
- Establish regular communication channels and open information-sharing among Consortium members.
- Build and maintain a strong network with members and stakeholders to ensure the most current events and topics aligned with the TGHC mission are cultivated and shared to elevate the profile of the TGHC.
- Oversee consortium meetings, including scheduling, agenda preparation, and dissemination of minutes.
- Supervise programmatic staff that implement a variety of on-going activities and convene working groups.
