Qualifications and Skills:

You must be able to motivate and energize students in a wide range of situations and settings. Leaders are on 24/7 for the duration of the program. Due to the high degree of independence and responsibility granted to leaders, successful candidates must have a substantial capacity to self-motivate, organize, lead, educate, mentor, and work well with others. Leaders will receive a stipend based on education level and relevant experience in addition to having all expenses paid during travel. Leaders are responsible for their own health insurance, and are required to have a minimal certification in Basic First Aid and CPR. Leaders must be present at a 4-day Leader Orientation in Putney, Vermont from June 5-8, 2014. Transportation to and from Orientation is paid for by Putney.

Candidates need to have significant travel experience in Rwanda or the surrounding countries, and a background in Public Health . Proficiency in French/Kinyarwanda is preferred.
