- 1. NOT support the Concealed Carry Reciprocity Act. This legislation will force states to allow anyone with a concealed carry permit from another state to carry a concealed gun in [your state] and is an egregious violation of state's rights.
- 2. Support gun violence restraining orders. These are also called "extreme risk protection orders" or "red flag" laws. These laws allow a family member or law enforcement to secure a court hearing to determine whether a firearm should be temporarily confiscated from a person who is deemed to be a danger to themselves or others.
- 3. Support universal background checks for buying guns. This will require background checks by licensed dealers and close a loophole that allows sales by non-licensed sellers.
- 4. Ban large capacity ammunition magazines. This will ban the sale or possession of magazines with a capacity of more than 10 rounds.
- 5. Raise the age for purchase and possession of rifles to 21. Congress already prohibits the purchase of handguns from licensed dealers for those under 21. This measure should be extended to long guns and should also apply it to private sellers and to gun possession.
- 6. Allow CDC to conduct research on gun violence, and add budget appropriations for CDC and NIH to conduct research on gun violence.
- 7. Require states submit firearm data when they request funding from the CDC. This data is critical to understanding the extent of the problems of gun violence across our country.
