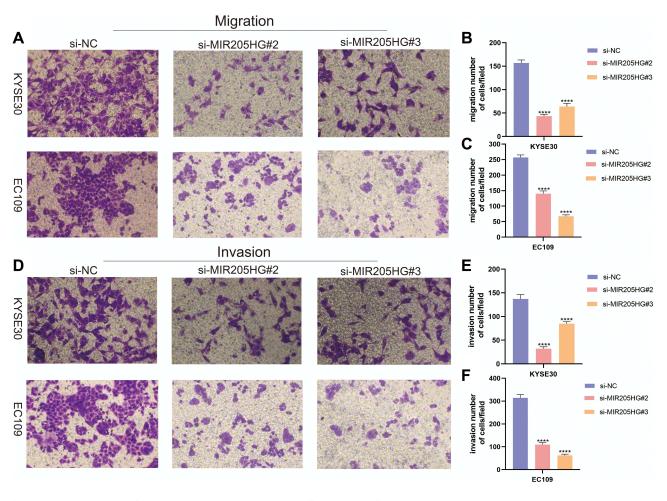


Figure 1 The authors apologize for this error and advise that this does not affect the results of the paper.
