- 1950 Appointed Director of Spiritual Life, Board of Evangelism of The Methodist Church.Moved to Nashville, Tennessee
- 1951 Lectures delivered in Little Rock, Arkansas, published as America Whither Bound?
- 1952 *America Whither Bound?* Presented by a Texas layman to all members of Congress.
- 1953 "Little House" erected at our summer home in Monroe, New Hampshire.

- 1956 Led sixty Methodist ministers in a mission to Great Britain, followed by seminars in Paris and Berlin.

- 1963 Elected delegate to the North Central Jurisdictional Conference.
- 1969 Dedication of the Thomas Parlor and Thomas Fellowship Hall of First Methodist Church, Birmingham
- 1970 Membership of First United Methodist Church of Birmingham reached 4,000.
- Retired from pastoral ministry; became Minister Emeritus at First United Methodist Church, Birmingham, Michigan.
 Honored with original musical play titled "Earnestly, Tenderly."
 - Moved to Nashville, Tennessee.
- 1972-78 Conducted Spiritual Life missions throughout the United States.
- 1978 Returned to Birmingham, Michigan.Became Personnel Consultant for the F. Joseph Lamb Company.
